BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE ANDES CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT that the following proposition be presented to the voters at the annual meeting of such voters to be held on Tuesday, May 16, 2023:

PROPOSITION

BE PRESENTED TO THE VOTERS AT THE ANNUAL

SHALL the Board of Education of the Andes Central School District be authorized to: (1) acquire a school bus at a maximum cost of approximately \$91,888; (2) expend such sum for such purpose; (3) levy the necessary tax therefore, to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education in accordance with Section 416 of the Education Law, taking into account state aid and trade-in value; and (4) in anticipation of the collection of such tax, issue bonds and notes of the District at one time or from time to time in the principal amount not to exceed \$77,388, and levy a tax to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Clerk is hereby directed to include notice of such proposition in the notice of the annual meeting.
