

**Andes Central School
Annual Meeting and Vote
May 16, 2023**

The meeting was called to order and the polls opened at 2:00 p.m.. There were 77 registered voters and 3 absentee ballots. The results of the voting were as follows:

RESOLVED, THAT THE Board of Education of Andes Central School District be and hereby is authorized to expend the sum not to exceed \$4,675,426.00 for school purposes in the 2023-2024 school year and to levy the necessary tax therefore.

Voting results: Yes – 62 No – 18

RESOLVED, THAT THE Board of Education of Andes Central School District shall be authorized to: (1) acquire a school bus at a maximum cost of approximately \$91,888; (2) expend such sum for such purpose; (3) levy the necessary tax therefore, to be levied and collected in annual installments in such years and in such amounts as may be determined by the Board of Education taking into account state aid and trade-in value; and (4) in anticipation of the collection of such tax, issue bonds and notes of the District at one time or from time to time in the principal amount not to exceed \$77,388, and levy a tax to pay the interest on said obligations when due.

Voting results: Yes – 60 No – 19

To elect one board member to the Board of Education for a 5 year term beginning July 1, 2023 and expiring June 30, 2028

Voting results: Alice DeVita received 54 votes

The District Clerk announced the above results and the annual meeting was adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
